

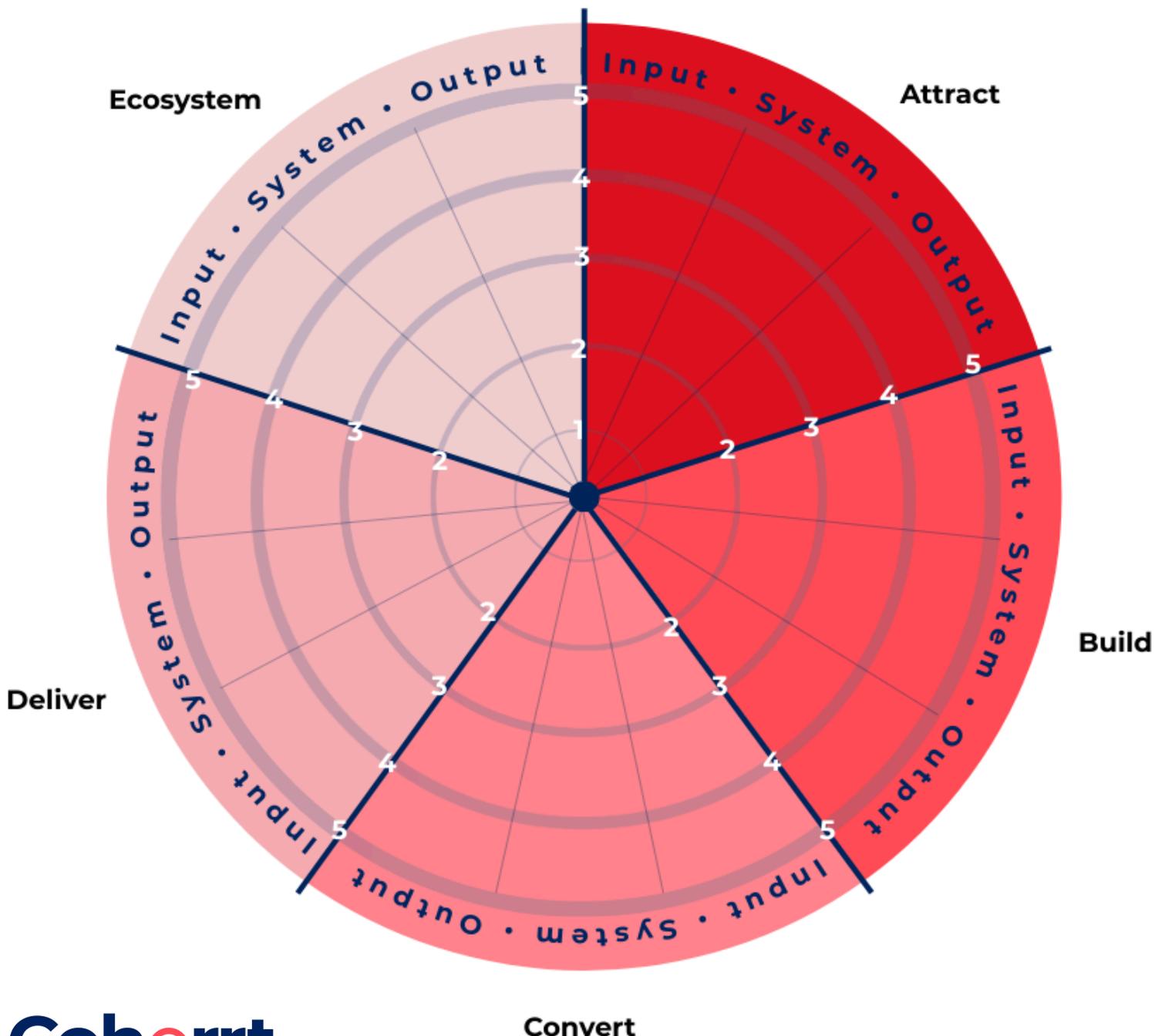
The Cohorrt Wheel

5 Drivers. 3 Lenses. One performance system.

Use the Wheel to assess the strength and balance of your commercial infrastructure across five Drivers:

Attract • Build • Convert • Deliver • Ecosystem

You're not scoring confidence.
You're scoring your operating system.



The Cohorrt Wheel

The 3 Lenses

INPUT

Your effort + resource deployment.

Are you investing deliberately — time, focus, tools, partnerships?

SYSTEM

Is there a defined, repeatable system?

Could someone follow it — or is it in your head?

OUTPUT

Are you achieving the desired outcome?

Is it consistent, measurable, and predictable?

How to Score (1-5)

Score each Driver through the three lenses using the scale below:

- 1 — Reactive / inconsistent / undefined
- 2 — Some activity, limited structure
- 3 — Functional but inconsistent
- 4 — Structured and measurable
- 5 — Repeatable, optimised, predictable

Two rules:

If it isn't defined, it isn't a 4.

If it isn't measurable, it isn't a 5.

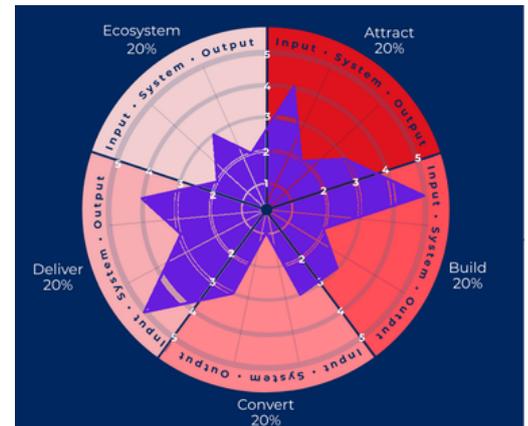
How to Read the Wheel

You are not aiming for perfect 5s.

You're looking for:

- Imbalance (one Driver carrying the whole system)
- Weak architecture (high Input, low System)
- Risk points (high Deliver, low Attract/Convert)
- Under-leverage (Ecosystem low or unmanaged)

The goal is portfolio resilience, built through structural balance.



What To Do Next

1. Identify your lowest-scoring Driver
 2. Identify the weakest lens within it (Input / System / Output)
 3. Apply pressure there first
 4. Re-score monthly (or quarterly minimum)
- Because what gets measured gets improved.
Independent — but not isolated.
